

## TJB Publishing Terms and Conditions

1. The competitions are run by TJB Publishing Limited (THE COMPANY) also trading as [www.school-events.co.uk](http://www.school-events.co.uk)
2. The competition is open to anyone living in the United Kingdom, of any age but must be a current full time student of a recognised School/Nursery within the United Kingdom.
3. Entry can only be made via our website and with the express permission of an adult with authority over the entrant under the age of 18.
4. By entering the competition, you agree to these terms and conditions.
5. Entries must be made by the closing date as posted on our website.

### *How to enter the competition*

6. Entries must be made via our website registration form, which is available at [www.school-events.co.uk](http://www.school-events.co.uk).
7. The winners will be announced via our website ([www.school-events.co.uk](http://www.school-events.co.uk)) by means of a candidate number.
8. Prizes will be sent by the company to the winning person/s at an agreed time suitable to both the company and the winners.
9. The prizes will be for the overall winner/s of each competition. We reserve the right to adjust the prize value and/or description of the physical award without notice.
10. Qualifying candidates to the competition are entitled up to 100% refund if a person is unwell/special circumstances and/or is unable to attend on the day of the competition. This needs to be accompanied by a legally recognised sick note or equivalent.
11. If the winner cannot be contacted or does not claim the prize within 14 days of notification, we reserve the right to withdraw the prize and pick a replacement winner.

22. All personal data collected (names and social media display names) will be deleted within one year/12 months after the competition ends.

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23. If some technical reasons should occur on behalf/by THE COMPANY and/or its web hosting provider then the event will either be rescheduled or cancelled. There will be no compensation to schools/students/parents/guardians/tutors/businesses for rescheduling or in the event of a cancellation for any reason. THE COMPANY will not be liable for any of the above mentioned reasons.
